

New arts group is launched in the city

A NEW arts organisation has been launched by members of a creative charity forced to close by funding cuts.

The artists behind Faceless, which closed in April, set up their new venture Edgelands Arts to continue the aim of bringing creativity to deprived and isolated communities.

Edgelands is already running dementia projects in libraries for Wakefield Council. Lead artist Bev Adams said: "At a time when the media portrays our communities as politically and socially divided, we feel a great need to come together creatively and share stories from the Edgelands."
